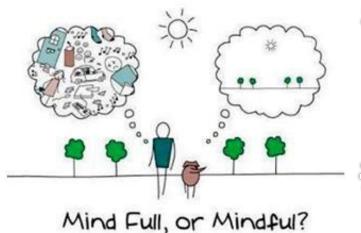
Clarity:

Let's reframe our definition...

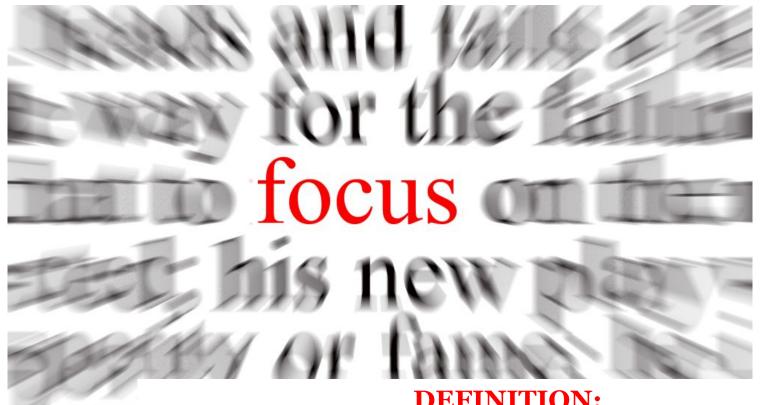
"doing what you said you would do" is keeping our promises.

Depth of Field
